In macOS version, I can no longer import .amos applications from Resources folder. Causes Import error.

It doesn't matter which disc archive it's from. I've tried importing code from:			
AMOSPro_Examples AMOSPro_Accessories AMOSPro_Tutorial AMOSPro_Productivity1 AMOSPro_Productivity2			
All produce the same " Problem during importation... " error. (See attachment.)			
An empty folder structure for the imported application is created, then it crashes with the attached error.			
For Example, for AMOSPro_Examples/Help_1.AMOS , I get the following folder structure:			
AMAL_1 resources filesystem application			
...and then the import fails.			
@Dave_B tried this in the PC version - which does work, so apparently, this is specific to the Mac version.
