Currently using Betaoz channel ver edu 1.x, if you try and import AMOS, it seems to do it now, but then it comes up with a window where you then cant click ok. All you can do is force close top right, eventually after about 5 times it exits.
The other thing is, I cant see where these files have actually gone to, I cant see them in my_aoz_applications currently or in the folder where the AMOS files were sourced from.
